Grambling State University (GSU) embraces the role that it plays in preparing high school students for postsecondary education. We offer programs and services that support high school graduates being able to easily transition into a university. One service offered provides feedback to high schools regarding the performance of their graduates enrolled at GSU.

The purpose of this communication is to share data with you on the performance of first-time freshmen students during the 2010 Fall semester who were graduates of your school. Thirteen graduates enrolled at Grambling State University during the 2010 Fall 2010 semester as first-time freshmen. The average grade point average for these

graduates at the end of the fall semester was 2.52 on a 4.00 scale. The highest grade point average earned by this group was 3.81. The lowest grade point average was 0. When the average grade point average for the graduate is compared to the average grade point average for the entire freshman class (2.383), the data indicates your graduates are competitive.

Notwithstanding, some first time freshmen have a harder time adjusting to the rigors of college life. To increase the success of high school graduates who had a rocky transition into the university, these students have been directed to our Office of Retention.
